1. Create a text tab like the one above to print on all of your posters, lawn signs, direct mail pieces, e-mails, websites, buttons, bumperstickers and emery boards (sponges too).
2. People interested in your campaign will text you to show interest, support or to receive information. They will receive a text from your campaign and will have subscribed to receive future communications.
3. Your campaign sets up a series of texts that advises people of events, polls them on issues, reminds them to vote, keeps them involved.

For only about 10¢, you are reaching people who have asked to be part of your campaign. It is easy to do. You can send them on your own, or Prime New York will send them for you.
