NEW FOR 2011: CELL PHONES

After many requests, we are happy to say that we have now added cell phone numbers to our voter file.

Cell phone numbers are compiled from a collection of websites that are created when the individuals fill out a form and opt in to offers. These individuals have marked the box that explains the data may be used for marketing. There are a multitude of sites that compile this data and the data is then stored at a clearing house that compiles the data for the end users that sell to marketers. Although there are some restrictions on the use of cell phone numbers for marketing, political calling is exempt from these restrictions.

In New York State, we now have over 1.4 million voters with cell phone numbers on our file – 356,159 have only cell phones on the file, while 1,384,006 have both cell phones and landlines.

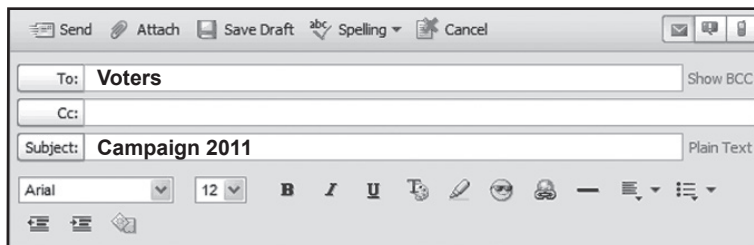
